VOCABULARY

Sketch

A **rough drawing or painting**, possibly to be looked at to be able to complete a finished drawing or painting

Line weight

The **strength, heaviness or darkness** of a line

Continuous line

A line which **does not end**. It keeps going

Form

Where an artist shows in a drawing or painting that an object is **3d rather than flat or 2d**

Print

Where an artist has created an **image on a block**, put paint or ink on the block and then placed paper on top of the block. The image on the paper is the print

Woodblock
print

Where a print is made by carving lines in a **block of wood**
